





Finalists announced 2014 Grace Cossington Smith art award

Finalist Exhibition 2 to 25 October 2014 Winner announced 7pm 9 October 2014

The Grace Cossington Smith Gallery and Abbotsleigh are delighted to announce that works by 15 artists have been shortlisted for the acquisitive Grace Cossington Smith art award. The winner will receive \$15,000 and the remaining finalists will receive \$1,000 each.

The selection panel for the 2014 Grace Cossington Smith art award includes distinguished artist Janet Laurence and Nicholas Tsoutas curator and Zelda Stedman Lecturer in Visual Arts Practice at Sydney College of the Arts.

Entries were received from around the country from artists who created two dimensional artworks responding to the theme of *Making Connections*.

The judges acknowledged that creating a shortlist of only 15 finalists from more than 350 submissions made the selection process very difficult. They were impressed by the variety and diversity of the submissions revealing great rigour and quality from artists at differing stages in their career.
