Grace Cossington Smith art award providing \$20,000 in prizes for Making Connections

The Grace Cossington Smith Gallery and Abbotsleigh are pleased to announce the Grace Cossington Smith art award has returned as a biennial award and with additional prize categories. The award theme is inspired by the work of Abbotsleigh Old Girl and artist Grace Cossington Smith who made connections with her changing world through her drawing and painting. The finalists have responded to and elaborated upon the theme of Making Connections and their personal approaches provide us with a glimpse into their ideas and experiences.

Submissions were invited from Australian artists, aged over 18, for original work in any two-dimensional media in response to the theme Making Connections. Over 375 entries were received from around the country.

The awards:

- \$15,000 awarded to the winner (acquisitive).
- \$2,500 awarded to an early career artist.
- \$2,500 awarded to a local artist from Hornsby and Ku-ring-gai area. Sponsored by Susie Stathakis and Di Jones Real Estate Wahroonga
- The winners share a three-week group exhibition at the GCS Gallery in November 2019

The award judges for the 2018 Grace Cossington Smith art award are Alison Clark, Team Leader Arts & Culture at North Sydney Council; and Dominik Mersch, Director of Dominik Mersch Gallery Rushcutters Bay. The judges selected 37 finalists and were impressed by the variety and diversity of the submissions revealing great rigour and quality from artists at differing stages in their career.

Abbotsleigh headmistress Mrs Megan Krimmer said 'I am delighted that Abbotsleigh is expanding our connections with our community and a broad range of artists. The variety of medium and the different interpretations of the theme certainly provide a fascinating, thought-provoking and stimulating exhibition.'
